Living Hope International has a long-term presence in Mexico, and the Esperanza Viva orphanage has been there for over ten years with many success stories. Our team will work directly with the EV staff for maximum impact.

There will be opportunities for construction on the new campus that the orphanage facilities are moving to. Or you can choose to be part of the team that will work directly with the orphan children.

Temperatures will be likely be in the 70s with lots of sunshine and minimal humidity.

The accommodations are neat and comfortable. Clean water and great meals are provided.

Any level of Spanish is helpful but not required to be effective.

Current Passport required.

Catalyst provides all logistics for the trip which includes pre-trip planning, training, required background checks, and receipting of donations as well as post-trip debriefing. All you do is show up ready to serve the Lord.

On-site housing, meals, in-country transportation and insurance are included.

Trained team leaders will be available to assist you.

Children right off the street. Definitely considered to be *the Least*. Some of them don't even remember their parents. They have struggled to survive on their own. This is the story of some of the children being cared for by the folks at Esperanza Viva (Living Hope). They provide housing, food, clothing, and education for these needy children; and with over 90 children, they are at capacity.

A piece of ground just outside of Puebla has been purchased to better meet the needs of the children and to provide space to taken in more kids. The development of this property has already begun.

Our team plans to assist the work of EV in two ways. First, we will have the opportunity to share Jesus' love with the children in simple yet effective ways. We can teach crafts and practical skills, play games with them and just spend time letting them know that Jesus loves them as we care for them.

Second, we plan to help with the construction of facilities on the new property. There are numerous structures to be built, including dorms, a kitchen, staff housing, and classrooms. We will join whichever part of the development that is underway when we arrive.
